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KITSUNE

PURSUE WITH CAUTION

Kitsune are renowned for their cunning and playful nature, often assuming human forms with fox-like features. These monsters are full of surprises, quick wit, and clever tricks.

THE WAYWARD'S ADVICE

Hidden Tails. The number of tails a kitsune possesses is a direct indicator of their age, wisdom, and power. Older kitsune retain their youthful appearances and develop deeply nurturing personalities, while younger kitsune are far more energetic and prone to mischief. Identifying a kitsune can be difficult, as they employ illusions to mask their fox-like features and blend into human society. A person dressed oddly for the setting or wandering alone at night may be a kitsune in disguise. Reacting too strongly to this discovery may cause them to vanish entirely. A composed response is the best way to keep them engaged.

Light Bringers. At their core, kitsune are both natural guardians and supreme tricksters, finding it necessary to both cause and cure the distress of others. They frequently insert themselves into people's lives, offering guidance and encouragement where needed. Some kitsune may even form deep relationships, driven by an innate desire to uplift and strengthen others. However, once a person is set on the right path, a kitsune will shift their focus. It's no fun to meddle in the life of someone already struggling—they prefer to wait until their target has stabilized before making up for lost time. Expect a relentless wave of pranks and trickery once a kitsune is satisfied with a person's progress.

Lore Savvy. Kitsune are avid collectors of trivia and insightful perspectives. When not engaged in playful mischief, they're sharing their wealth of knowledge with others. While a kitsune won't initiate discussions on their favorite topics outright, they have a knack for steering conversations toward them, subtly weaving their interests into dialogue. They also tend to explain obscure facts as if their listeners are already familiar, teasing people who struggle to follow their leaps in logic. This habit makes them entertaining conversationalists but frustratingly difficult to debate.

SAFE TO PURSUE

Moths gather for leisure around a mystical flame that defines their culture and mindsets. Light levels play a crucial role in both a moth's productivity and ability to relax.

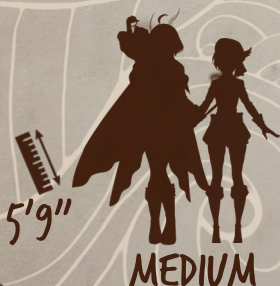
THE WAYWARD'S ADVICE

Distracted Glow. Strong light sources can easily distract moths, pulling them away from tasks to hover by the glow. They require complete darkness to function productively, and soft, glowing light to unwind. Overexposure to light will send them into a euphoric state, being unable to focus on anything else and losing track of time. Planning events with moths means carefully considering the lighting that will be present, as it heavily affects their behavior.

Focused Interests. Moths often hyper-fixate on specific interests and try to steer conversations toward familiar topics. While they may struggle with new subjects, once something clicks for a moth, they'll pursue it with intense passion and curiosity.

Sacred Light. Moths are mesmerized by an eternal fire known as the Lavender Flame, located in their largest flower field. This mystical fire not only influences moth fashion with its vibrant color and radiant glow, but also symbolizes the center of their culture and social interests. A moth's home will always be close to the Lavender Flame, getting deeply homesick if they haven't basked in its warmth in awhile. Moths always invite trusted individuals to check out the flame during special events. The perimeter is lined with vendors and attractions designed to dazzle. Locals assume that a moth bringing an outsider in means they're in love, and won't hesitate to make cheeky comments. Be prepared with witty responses to avoid outright denying the possibility—nothing's worse than a flustered "we're just friends" shutting things down.

Sunny Seasons. Moths love the warmer months and hate the cold seasons. Don't be alarmed if a moth begins to push aside dates when the temperature drops. Although the monster always has fluffy outfits prepared for the cold, they'll still lose interest in anything that'll have them stepping outside.

An eventful gift from a moth

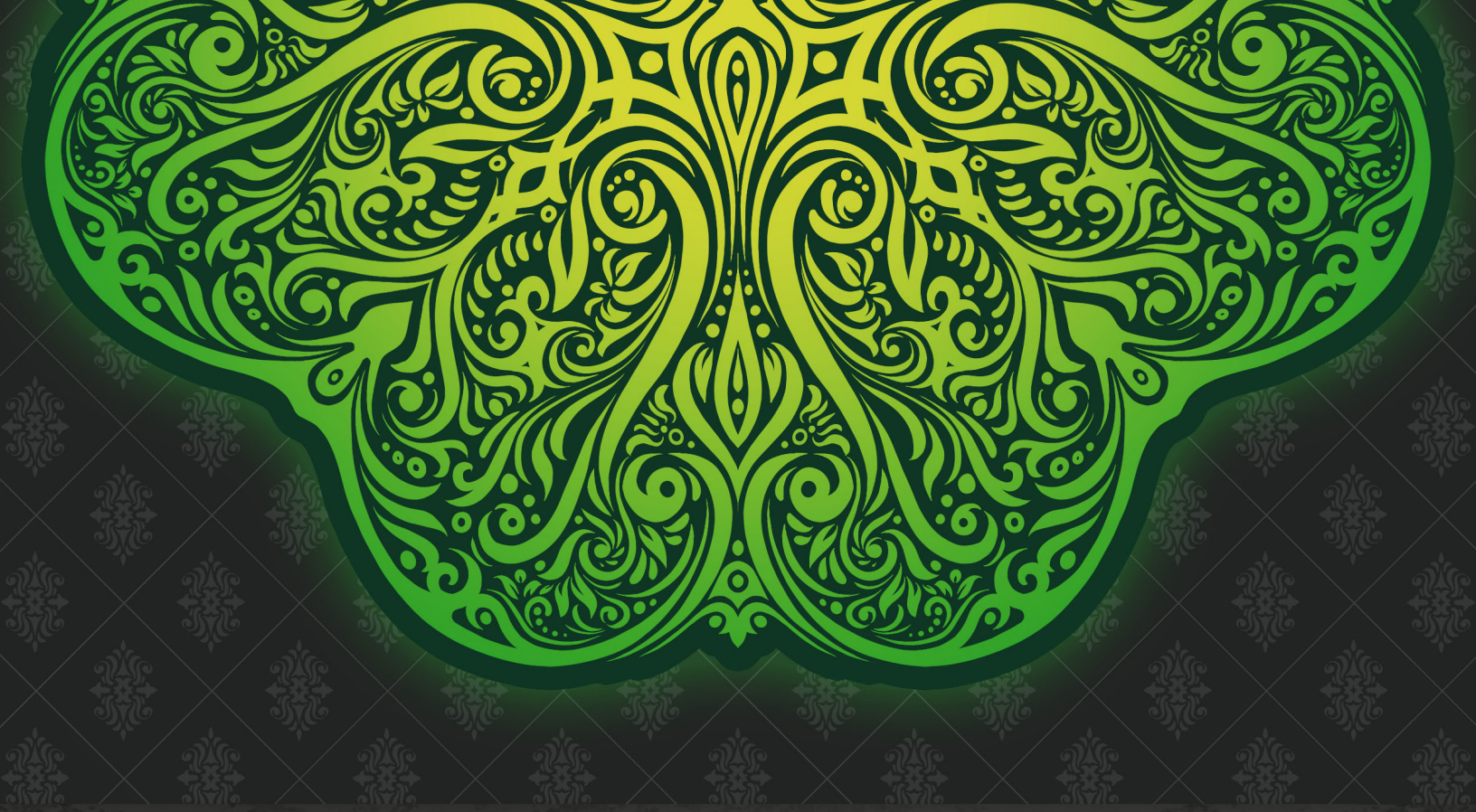
Lavender torches are carved and lit exclusively in protected moth habitats. The slow-burning wood contains properties that chemically alter the flame's color to a brilliant lavender hue. Torches crafted from this wood aren't just functional but also works of art, with intricate carvings adorning their specially crafted handles. During events, moths craft these torches with care and trade them with others, creating a breathtaking scene of purple wisps weaving through the forest when lit. The torches are often compared to bouquets of flowers, with each one reflecting the thoughtfulness of its creator. While non-moths are prohibited from harvesting the wood, they're welcome to purchase pre-carved torches from local artisans to participate in the festivities. To light these torches, every moth community maintains a large central flame in the marketplace, ignited only during events. Lighting fires anywhere else in the forest is strictly forbidden, requiring all participants to gather at the marketplace. Be prepared to hold your lit torch high to avoid burning others in the crowd!



FOX MASK

A common gift from a kitsune

These elegant masks are handmade by kitsune and combined with a tuft of their hair. The result is a mask that, when worn, allows the wearer to completely transform into a multi-tailed fox. The mask merges with their body, and everything else they're wearing falls to the ground. As kitsune can already transform into foxes, they hand out these masks to disguise others and get up to mischief as a pair. The day one is handed out, expect to be thrown into a world of shenanigans as the monster tests how devious a person can be; this is where most of the bonding between a kitsune and a potential romantic partner stems from. It's important to come up with tasteful ways to toy around with others, and keep up with the kitsune and their equally devious plans. Being given this item is also a kitsune committing themselves to someone, as their magic can only extend to one mask, and they will ask for them back if things aren't working out. So long as a person is in possession of the mask, they shouldn't have to worry about the monster seeing other partners.



DATE SPOTS!



QUEEN'S CASINO

Bouncers make quick work judging the coin and character of guests eager to enter. Inside the massive establishment, lights glint off golden accents and betting machines buzz by every corner. Servers refill shots and hover by patrons who shine a rich presence. Fortune favors the bold!

PREPARATIONS

Dress Code. The intricate designs of the slot machines and betting tables are rivaled only by the extravagant outfits of the clientele. Countless visitors are denied entry by fashion sense alone, so dress to impress before rolling up. VIPs of the casino regularly break this tradition and waltz in how they please, their status commanding entry.

Pay-to-Play. The enthralling interior of the casino is unrivaled in its ability to promote spending coin. It's important to have a purse large enough for a night of high stakes, and to match the spending of partners to avoid running out of funds to continue playing together.

Entertained. Guests who only believe the casino is a place for high stakes bets will burn up in a flash. It's important to be aware of the countless other forms of cheaper pleasures, such as live performances by the cash-out desk, a museum's worth of historical statues and murals, and the bounty of snacks offered by servers.

CASINO ENCOUNTERS

D6 Encounter

1 Whatever game the daters were neck-deep in is soured by a fight that breaks out. As someone gets thrown through the air, there's a moment to react before bets are off the table.

2 The manager of the Queen's Casino makes a rare appearance. They're akin to a celebrity in the establishment, and their presence alone is enough to pull daters apart in pursuit of catching their attention.

3 One of the daters wins a jackpot, but the staff claim foul play. As an investigation is underway, daters may become off-put by each other's questions and suspicions.

4 A **delideer** arrives with plenty of mystery boxes! Prizes and misfortunes inside range from minor to life-changing, with guests being offered their first free of charge.

5 An opponent is playing by one-upping a dater's bets at every turn. They seem keen on throwing others off their game and flaunting their wealth (or the dater's lack thereof).

6 Drinks are on the house! The alcohol is designed to keep people awake and kick their risk-taking mindsets into high gear!



MARIA GORO

Gambler Manager

Maria appears as a beacon of whimsical chaos to everyone in her presence. To a bystander, her character seems like an endlessly rehearsed comedic act performed tirelessly throughout the night. Even as the manager, Maria makes an exceptional effort to interact with the building's capacity's worth of patrons before returning to her office. She lingers around newcomers and VIPs most frequently, ensuring old and new visitors feel welcomed to start betting.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Final Wagers. Patrons on a winning streak are met with the allured gaze of Maria, who giddily offers a final game. Risking their prize pool, victory would only mean getting a date with the manager. Unsurprisingly, nobody has ever taken up the offer.

Special Event. Maria's a master at planning massive events for her friends' and patrons' enjoyment. Elaborate games and wild prizes are always on the table as Maria works with her staff to create once-in-a-lifetime experiences. It's a passion she funds entirely through the casino and gives straight back to the community.



RAGS

Stirge Gambling Addict

Rags is an endlessly optimistic monster with an insatiable desire to hit it big by any means necessary. Sadly, any attempt at doing so falls short as her inability to plan long-term leads her back into the casino to splurge on get-rich-quick schemes. The girl is at her highest point of adrenaline while risking it all, and crowds gather around to watch the underdog fail again at claiming one of the house's jackpots.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Cunning Plans. No amount of failure can keep Rags down. As soon as the stirge gets paid from a month's assortment of dubious work, she immediately returns to the gambling hall with another ill-conceived game-plan to win it big.

VIP Style. Rags sews together obtrusive outfits made from discarded fabrics in an effort to fit in with the ingenious costumes of casino VIPs. Although anywhere else would note the style as homeless-core, bouncers at the Queen's Casino believe it to be high fashion, and Rags a monster of high status.



THE FANTASY FAIR

The Fantasy Fair is a yearly event that allows common folk to live the legends of heroes! Guests take roles as knights and are given quests to complete. From unstable minecart coasters to royal jousts for glory, real heroes were inspired here.

PREPARATIONS

Legends. Many of the attractions at the Fantasy Fair include references to real heroes. The fair has gone to great lengths to preserve this history in an interactive way. Being recognized as an actual hero can cause crowds to form, making it hard to enjoy the fair without celebrity status slowing the fun down.

Limits. Guests are assigned to a faction and given different quest scrolls based on personal comfort. Each offers a scaling intensity for attractions, from slower coasters, the cushioning joust lances, to the severity of irritating traps in the wicked tower. Expect victory oriented partners to demand all of their quests get done, and monsters who like a challenge to always prefer the hardest quests.

Red Winners. At the end of every three day fair event, the completed quests from each faction are tallied separately. A red dragon monster then soars through the sky alongside fireworks spelling the winning faction's name. Don't forget to stick around after dark to see it!

FANTASY FAIR ENCOUNTERS

D6 Encounter

- 1 A prize catches a dater's eye, but the game to win it is absurdly difficult! It'd be cheaper to buy it directly with coin, but who doesn't want to show off their skill?
- 2 A dater loses an item on one of the fast-paced attractions. Finding it without wasting too much time would be heroic.
- 3 A group of actors playing as bandits block the path of the daters. They demand the couple wear paper hats that make fun of themselves to cross. Brandishing a wooden prop weapon from a gift shop will scare the bandits to let the daters through!
- 4 The minecart coaster ride malfunctions just as the daters make it to the front of the line.
- 5 A real fight breaks out between fairgoers, requiring someone to either deescalate or subdue an offender before somebody gets hurt.
- 6 A jester riles up the daters to shoot a few arrows at a bullseye in an effort to plunge the monster into water. Some daters may take it a bit too personal!



MOXIE

Wolf Weapons Dealer

Moxie is a woman of few words to adults and has endless patience for children. She mans the front of her prop weapon tent at the Fantasy Fair to sell blunt swords. For kids, Moxie gladly offers free lessons on basic weapon techniques. Adults looking to gain her respect, however, need to already be skilled with weapons; the wolf finds grown amateurs to be beneath her. These shifts from approachable to cold often catch people around Moxie off guard.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Early Trainer. Moxie believes that children should be trained to effectively wield weapons as soon as possible and uses the Fantasy Fair as an outlet to interest them. As such, she also sees adults who are incapable of proper swordsmanship as powerless pushovers who are ignorantly evading essential skills.

Smuggled Weapons. Moxie stashes her favorite shortsword and hand claw weapons in the back of her tent. Adults who prove themselves are signaled to follow her and check them out. The craftsmanship alone exceeds most basic magic weapons.



PENNY PALWICK

Jester Dunk Booth Heckler

Penny works at the dunk booth of the Fantasy Fair. Even when on break, she can't help but make crude remarks toward everyone she encounters. Penny secretly despises her role at the park and craves the court jester positions that were given to her two sisters years ago. She takes her frustrations out on others, which works well at her fair booth but makes it hard to socialize after work.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Exaggerated. Penny enjoys conversations where everyone exaggerates things. She acts normal in basic situations but comes up with over-the-top ways to retell the stories later. The jester believes this makes her simple life far more interesting.

Wicked Within. Having an equally crude personality is the easiest way to engage with Penny. The jester enjoys snide comments, vulgarity, and insults around closer friends, seeing it as playful. People who can't dish it back tend to be ignored in favor of those who are better at jokingly getting under others' skin.
